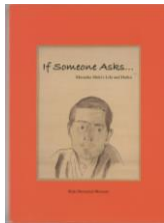


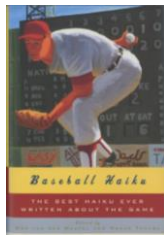
MASAOKA SHIKI A SKETCH OF HIS LIFE (Book)

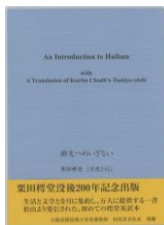
Baseball Haiku (Book)
